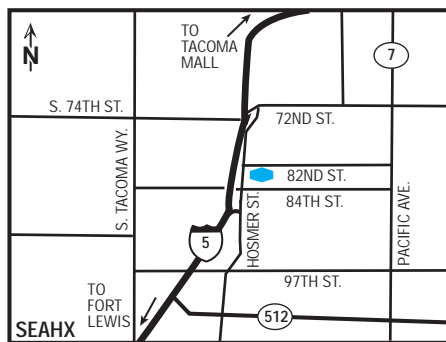

directions to our hotel

Traveling North on I-5: Take Exit 128 toward South 84th Street and turn Left onto S Hosmer St. Travel two blocks to the hotel on your right. Traveling South on I-5: Take Exit 129 toward South 72nd/84th Street stay in left lane and turn slight right onto Tacoma Mall Blvd then turn right onto S 74th Street and across the overpass. S 74th Street becomes S 72nd Street. Follow the right turning lane and turn slight right onto S Hosmer Street. Travel four blocks to the hotel on your left.

world's largest privately owned automobile collection

Harold E. LeMay amassed the largest privately owned collection of automobiles, motorcycles, trucks, other vehicles and related memorabilia in the world. At its peak, the LeMay Collection numbered in excess of 3,000 vehicles and thousands of artifacts. The Collection, recognized by many as a national treasure, represents the American experience with the automobile as it spans the 20th century and features virtually every American make as well as numerous foreign cars. The LeMay Collection is listed in the Guinness Book of World Records as the largest privately owned collection in the world.

cowboy hat and boots

The largest hat and cowboy boots in America, Hat 'n' Boots is a world famous roadside attraction and landmark in the Georgetown neighborhood of Seattle, Washington. A former gas station, the City of Seattle moved the Hat 'n' Boots to the new Oxbow Park in December, 2003 to preserve the landmark.

Hampton's third landmark refurbishment of the summer will be the one-of-a-kind whimsical concrete cowboy "Hat N' Boots" - just south of Seattle. Intended to catch the eye of the motorists traveling along what was then the main highway between Seattle and Tacoma, the cowboy-themed gas station was built in 1955 as part of a half-completed shopping center. The station office was canopied by the giant cowboy hat measuring 44 feet in diameter, and the 22-foot tall boots housed restrooms. Legend has it that Elvis pumped gas for his Cadillac at the Hat 'n' Boots while filming "It Happened at the World's Fair" in Seattle in 1963. Seattle-area painter and designer Lewis H. Nasmyth carefully designed the boots "stitch by stitch and wrinkle for wrinkle in structural steel." Nasmyth built the structures by hand out of steel beams, chicken wire and plaster. Today, Hat n' Boots is the only Seattle landmark remaining from the 1950s era of mimetic architecture - affectionately known as 'roadside kitsch' or "'oddball' architecture.' The structure was relocated to Oxbow Park for preservation in December 2003 (just a couple of blocks from its original site).
